Thought for the Week:

The emphasis should be on restructuring how people work together. That's what ultimately has an effect on the classroom... Which is why we have our PLC!

(Teachers as leaders! Working together to create POWER STANDARDS, learning targets (I Can Statements), and effective common assessments; sharing data and how that data can be used effectively; maintaining a focus on the 4 critical questions of a PLC: **What do we want students to know** (Power Standards), **how do we know they learned it** (Assessments), **what do we do if they haven't learned it** (Differentiation/reteach using other strategies/ small group work/interventions), and **what do we do if they already know it?** (Differentiation/enrichment)
